#### **VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXTRA COST OPTIONS FOR 2024**

#### **Dear Parents**

The Kyilla Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Voluntary Contributions and Extra Cost Options for 2024. The information in this letter is an explanation of where funds requested will be spent. Included with this letter is the Schedule of Charges for 2024. Amounts shown are the maximum the school can charge for activities in 2024.

# Voluntary Contributions

Paying the Voluntary Contributions makes a significant difference to our school budget. Money is used to purchase resources which children use throughout the school year such as reading books, library books, art equipment, and consumables for science experiments and maths equipment. Please pay the \$60.00 per student contribution at the beginning of the year. This equates to \$1.50 per week.

# ICT - Voluntary Approved Request

We also have a Technology Voluntary Approved Request for our students in years Pre-primary - Year 6 of \$40.00 per student. This contribution goes toward ensuring our students have access to reliable, up-to-date technology infrastructure to further enhance their classroom learning. This money goes toward maintenance and app purchases.

# Charges and Extra Cost Options

These charges are in addition to the \$60.00 per student voluntary contribution.

Additional information for some specific items:

#### 1. Excursions and Incursions

Throughout the year children are involved in excursions (such as a trip to the Perth Zoo, AQWA, WA Museum, Scitech) and payment is needed to cover the cost of the bus and entry into the venue. Generally, excursions are arranged by teachers and can involve more than one class. Incursions can be a play, music or an activity presented by an external provider on the school site, for example Edu-Dance.

Year 6 students also attend a graduation lunch and an excursion to celebrate their final year of primary school.

# In-term Swimming and Swimming Carnival

Students from Pre-primary to Year 6 attend two weeks of swimming lessons at Beatty Park. Lessons are given by qualified swimming instructors and organised by the Department of Education. The charge includes bus fare and pool entry.

The swimming carnival for children from Year 3 to Year 6, includes the cost of the bus fare and pool hire for the duration of the event.

# 2. Protective Behaviours

Students from Pre-primary to Year 4 will participate in the 'Keep us Safe' program which is facilitated by an external provider. Keep Us Safe promotes key messages about personal safety, protective behaviours and wellbeing. Year 5 to Year 6 will learn Growth and Development as part of the Health Curriculum

Parent workshops for this program may be held during the year.

# 3. Music (Choir) Excursions

Some students participate in the choir. This amount is used to cover the costs of bus travel to and from choir activities such as the Massed Choir Festival at the Perth Concert Hall.

#### 4. Interschool Costs

Some students are selected to participate in Interschool Carnivals in athletics, football, soccer, netball and cross country. This amount is used to cover the cost of bus travel and entry to hired venues for these events.



# 5. Year 6 Camp

All Year 6 students will be able to attend the camp held in Term 4.

# 6. Instrumental Music

A small number of Year 5 and 6 students will be given the opportunity to learn an instrument through the Department's School of Instrumental Music. The charge covers the cost of instrument hire (Brass and Clarinet) in Year 5 only. Year 6 students learning the Baritone are also able to hire their instrument.

**NOTE:** Brass and Clarinet students may also join the Mt Hawthorn Area Band, and a charge is payable to Mount Hawthorn Primary School P&C, to cover costs.

# 7. Graduation Costs

Parents are required to fund graduation items. Examples of these costs include Leavers' T-shirts, Year Book and memory bear/ball.

(Please note: Fundraising by parents means that the costs associated with graduation are reduced.)

8. PEAC Program

Some students are selected to participate in PEAC; extension programs arranged by the Department. Dependent upon the program, there may be associated course costs.

# Payment Options (not payable until February 2024)

Voluntary Contribution, Voluntary Approved Request – ICT Levy and Charges can be paid in advance (**Option 1**) or as you go (**Option 2**). Funds paid in Option 1 will be automatically applied to each excursion when added to your child's account.
